NV Terra Mädi Brut Reserva, Querétaro

The Terra Mädi Brut Reserva is a true blend of European production technique with Mexican terroir. Freixenet Mexico produced at Finca Sala Vivé, their winery is in Ezequiel Montes, Querétaro in central Mexico. The uniqueness and quality of this wine comes from the "extreme winemaking" practiced in the region due to the microclimate and outright clay soil. A blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes, this wine gives flavors of white cherry, yellow apple, green strawberry and crème brûlée.



2017 Gómez Cruzada Crianza, Rioja

A Spanish Rioja from a Mexican producer! 80% Tempranillo and 20% Garnacha from vineyards in the foothills of the Cantabria mountain range, this wine has great personality, with freshness and a very fruity character. This vintage is reminiscent of Rioja's classic vintages with great potential for aging. Plum and bramble aromas with lightly spiced savory hints envelop the palate. Alluvial, sandstone clay, ferrous clay soils and 12 months in mostly new American oak barrels create a smooth approachable Crianza with ripe dark fruits and supple tannins.



2019 Hacienda Del Marques Shiraz Blend, Coahuila

This blend hails from Parras de la Fuente Coahuila, gifted with an ideal terroir and surrounded by pecan trees. They best vines were selected from Château Mercier in France to produce this wine. 65% Shiraz, 25% Merlot, and 10% Cabernet, this wine gives notes of dried fruit, red fruit compote, minerality and notable acidity. This 4th generation owned and operated winery utilizes new world techniques from Chile, Argentina, California and Australia to take their wine to the next level.



2019 Las Nubes Bodegas y Viñedos "Selección de Barricas Tinto", Valle de Guadalupe

Las Nubes is a leader of high quality wines in Baja California. Using second use French and American barrels for six months give this wine a delicate caramel scent in the finish with hibiscus notes throughout. Complex notes of cherries, raspberries, currants, and aromas of wood and flowers permeate through this wine. Intense, firm tannins, and dry, long-lasting finish make this wine extremely expressive.



2018 Hacienda Florida Cabernet Blend

Beautiful leafy walnut trees in the General Cepeda Region, very close to the city of Saltillo Coahuila are the backdrop for this winery. This Cabernet blend is 55% Cabernet Sauvignon and 45% Shiraz, it boasts aromas of spiced black cherry and flavors of black currants, mocha and roasted nuts. Round and structured on the palate with well balanced tannins it finishes with floral and vanilla notes.



2019 Bodegas Henri Lurton Le Nebbiolo, Valle de Guadalupe

Aged for 14 months in new French oak barrels, this wine shows bright elegance and firm but round tannins with a slight juiciness. This dense and balanced wine has excellent aging potential. Balsamic aromas of rosemary, thyme and fresh cherry showcase the purity and expressiveness of the bouquet. Le Nebbiolo originates from a vineyard in the San Vicente Valley and is harvested specifically for complexity and aromatics.
